Club descriptions:

Archery Club: Coach Batista is a certified archery instructor. He will teach students the safety rules of the shooting range and the fundamental steps of archery. Students will practice shooting arrows from 10 meters and 15 meters. We will make an archery team and compete against other schools in the U.S. (virtual matches). This will be an exciting and fun club. The school will provide the bows and arrows, but students are welcome to bring their own equipment if desired. Available for students in 5th to 12th grade.

Slack-Line Club: This club will be lead by Ms. Duke and she will teach the students how to balance and walk on the slack-line. Students will also learn the safety rules of the sport and how to properly set up a slack-line. This is an excellent and fun activity for kids to improve balance, body control and coordination. Available for students in 3rd to 12th grade.

International Fair & Homework club: This club is open to students in 3rd to 12th grade. Students will be given the opportunity to work on their International Fair assignments and homework after school in the computer lab. Teachers will assist students with any questions they may have on their projects and homework. This club will be led by Mr. Knutson.

Snacks and Crafts Club: This is for students in grades PreK3 to 2nd and it will be taught by Mrs. Knutson. Come on out and each week we will make a creative and yummy snack and an interesting craft! We may also read a story, sing a song, or play a game to go along with our snacks and crafts. This will be a great time! (This club will have a maximum of twelve students).
